2. Judging

This competition will be judged using the International Judging System.

3. Entries

Entries are only accepted online via Cognito Forms. The official entry form must be used. Entries **open** at **7:00pm GMT on Tuesday 9th September 2025** and close at **11:59pm on Friday 12th September 2025**.

UK Skaters must be eligible members of British Ice Skating with a valid membership.

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt of application and payment by category. Places may be limited due to available ice time.

All competitors must be ready to skate at least 30 minutes before the published time. The timetable is provisional and may be subject to change.

Withdrawals prior to the closing date will be subject to a £25 administration fee. Withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded.

The cost for entering one Singles Segment is £90. If entering both the Short and Free Program at National 6, 7 or 8, the cost will be £140.

4. Sportity

All official communications, timetables and updates will be published via the Sportity app. **The Sportity channel name and password will be provided by British Ice Skating (BIS).**

5. Practice Ice

Practice ice may be available during the event. Information regarding practice sessions will be published on Sportity.

6. Music

All required music must be submitted via the online entry form as mp3 files. Files should be named "COMPETITION LEVEL_SKATER NAME" (e.g., NATIONAL8MENSHORT_JOE BLOGGS). Two spare clearly labelled USBs must also be brought to the event.

7. Planned Programme Content

The Planned Programme Content Sheet must be submitted online with the entry form. It must be completed accurately in English using ISU terminology.

8. Accreditation

Accreditation will be available at the ice rink upon arrival.

9. Presentation of Medals

The first three placed competitors in each category will be announced and honoured.

10. Insurance / Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Tayside Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials, and team members. Such insurance must cover full medical attendance and repatriation costs. **The Organiser assumes no responsibility for personal injury, property damage, or expenses incurred in connection with the event.**

11. Timetable and Draws

A provisional timetable will be published shortly after the closing date on Sportity. Draws will be conducted electronically through the ISU judging system, and starting orders will be published the day before competition.

12. Hotels
