All competition criteria are as per ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules 2024 relating to the discipline for the season 2024 / 2025 and all up to date ISU Communications.

All competitions will be run in accordance with ISU criteria for the 2024/2025 season. Skaters and their coaches are strongly advised to read all the relevant communications when available on the ISU website www.isu.org

2. Judging

This competition will be judged using the international judging system.

3. Entries

We are only accepting online entries. Entries can be made via the link on British Ice Skating Website and the Sportity app. The official online entry forms must be used. Opening Thursday 29th August 2024 BST

3.1 The entries should reach the organiser no later than end of day Thursday September 5th 2024. However we reserve the right to close entries and bring the official closing date forward if the event fills up. Please ensure entry is sent in good time to avoid disappointment.

3.2 UK Skaters must be an eligible member of British Ice Skating with a valid membership.
International Skaters from outside U.K. do NOT need to be members of British Ice Skating.

3.3 Entries for individual events will be accepted in order of receipt of application forms and entry fee, and places may be limited due to available ice time.

3.4 All Competitors must be ready to skate at least half an hour before the time stated on the timetable. The timetable is provisional and will be subject to change.

3.5 If any of the categories are over subscribed, they may be divided by age. For Singles and Pairs, Beginners to National 3, the age is calculated as at the closing date. For the ISU categories, age is calculated as at the previous 1st of July.

3.6 The Tayside Trophy Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without reason.

3.7 Withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded for any reason, Withdrawals prior to closing date will be subject to a £25 admin fee.

3.8 If the test requirements for the category entered are incorrect at the closing date, the entry will be considered invalid and will be withdrawn and therefore **should have no refund**.

3.9 The cost for **entering** 1 Singles or Pairs Segment is **£85**. **If entering** both the Short and Free program of the National 6, National 7 or National 8 events, the cost will be **£135**

Payment can be made via the link available on the Entry Form and must be done in order for the entry to be accepted.

Refunds for unsuccessful entries will not include any processing fees charged via stripe.

Refunds for any withdrawals before deadline will be minus a £25 processing fee

Withdrawals after the deadline will not be refunded

4. Practice Ice

Practice ice may be available during the event. Information regarding practices will be made available on the sportity app.

5. Music

All required music shall be submitted via the online entry form at time of completion. Uploads should be submitted as an “mp3” only. Please name file as “COMPETITION LEVEL_SKATERS NAME” for example “NATIONAL 8MENSHORT_JOEBLOGGS”. Please ensure you have 2 spare clearly labelled USB’s.

6. Planned Programme Content

The Planned Programme Content Sheet will be able to be entered online along with the entry form and **MUST** be completed. It is mandatory that the Planned Programme Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the terminology for the elements listed in respective ISU Communication.

7. Accreditation

The official accreditation will be available at the ice rink upon arrival.

8. Presentation of Medals

The first three best-placed competitors in each event will be announced and honored.

9. Insurance/Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in Tayside Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organiser assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors or Officials, Limited to the extent permitted by the Unfair Contract Terms Act 1977

In addition no refund can be given for any withdrawal and claims should be made against your own personal and or travel insurance.

10. List of competitors and Timetable/Draws

A provisional timetable will be made available on our website shortly after the closing date. Please do not contact us with regards to this.

The draws for all categories will be done electronically/automatically, randomized by the ISU Judging system-computer. The starting orders will be published the day before the event takes place.

11. Hotels

Official Hotels & Restaurants
